Sam stated that the flagpole is a project he is working on including new ropes. This is a spring project. Sandra stated the city has this on the agenda, confirmed Sam.

Clerk: Water audits were not given in January. Sandra stated that she had Covid in January, was super sick and missed a little over a week of work. Sandra stated that she did receive a call asking about notices. Sandra stated the city however did not have many that were late. Sandra stated that starting in the month of March water bills will look different due to form change. Council was given a review of the new forms. Sandra stated to the council that the forms allow for more information, including last payment amount received. Sandra stated to the council that the form change was due to working with RVS on trouble shooting issues on previous forms, form size was an issue with printer compatibility. Sandra stated that she investigated the Robocall request from the past council discussions. She was in contact with a company called One Call Now. Sandra gave council the email print out for council to review. Sandra explained to council that 1000 prepaid credits would be \$90. 1 Credit equal 1 Call. Sam stated that the main reason robocall would be a good idea is to inform our community on things like water leaks, water boil orders, events, local emergencies that would not be covered via Page County system. Sam explained that not everyone uses our website or face book. Sandra stated she currently has 120 numbers from the RVS water accounting system. Sandra stated that she is aware that the system will need to be updated. Council discussed the pros of the having a Robocall system for the city. A motion was made to go forward with the system.

Compliance Review for ICAP was done in December, Sandra received the results of the review in January. Sandra stated it is the job of the officer to find "things" wrong and there were 2 items on the review. The first item was insurance cards not on file, Sandra stated that has been corrected. Sandra stated the second item was the insurance officer wants the city to build a containment wall around the tank, due to it being a single wall tank. Sam stated that the cost of that for how little fuel the tank holds for the city per year, is not cost effective. Council discussed why the containment wall is needed, for environment purpose. Council discussed several options of what to do with the tank as the tank does not hold a lot of fuel. Several options were purposed, including selling of the tank after fuel is used. Council and Sam discussed that would leave his options of filling the tractor either with gas cans or take the tractor to Braddyville to Trax Mart. Sam stated to the council that he will leave it to the council on their decision. Council discussed further and the tank was decided to be sold after use of current fuel. Sandra stated she would let the compliance officer know in her report.

Council: Sherry discussed that the city hall flag has had some complaints. Sandra stated that there is a flag that has been purchased already for city hall. Sam stated that he does have a flag and new ropes that will be replaced. That is on his list of items to due once weather settles. Sherry mention to city about replacement of lines if the city needs to do that. She stated what would be the cost factor for a street replacement. Sherry spoke on the age of water/sewer system. Sam stated the main lines are ok. A smoke test was performed several years ago. The leaks that the city had were not due to major line breaks. Ron and Sam stated to do an overhaul of system cause be very expensive and would require the city to get grants and bonds, like the city currently has from previous work. Council discussed briefly.
